And, to be included in the first season ever where all three directors are female is so exciting! But the icing on the birthday cake was having these three talented actors audition for me. It's a director's dream to have authentic chemistry between actors, and mine came true with this cast. Leon, Bill and Justine were born in rehearsals amidst rich discussions exploring character backgrounds, personalities, with never-ending laughs and 90+ hours of dedicated efforts. Working with this cast while collaborating with our very talented production team on set design, set décor and costumes has enhanced my knowledge in direction, stretched my creative boundaries, and provided an introspection that has touched my soul. Special thanks to mentors Sandra Curran, Mary Camastra, Dave Wyllie, and Lesley Quinn Stankaitis for their instrumental guidance.

Personally, the two most challenging and rewarding roles I've ever accepted are that of spouse and parent. After 34 years of marriage, two amazing sons, and a wonderful daughter-in-law, I'm so pleased my husband and I have followed our hearts and not prioritized perfection. "There's no such thing as perfection. You don't fall in love with a perfect person. You fall in love by learning to see an imperfect person perfectly."

ABOUT THE PLAYWRIGHT



Norm Foster

Norm Foster has been called Canada's preeminent comic playwright. He is the most produced playwright in the history of the country and he receives, on average, an astounding 150 productions of his plays each year. It has been said that on any given day of the year, there is a Norm Foster play either in rehearsal or in performance somewhere in the world.

Halifax Chronicle-Herald columnist Ron Foley writes "Foster's stage writing remains one of Canada's greatest theatrical treasures," and The Calgary Herald describes him as "one of the funniest writers of intelligent comedy in Canadian theatre today."

Mr. Foster has over 65 plays to his credit, including *The Foursome*, *The Melville Boys*, *Wrong For Each Other*, *The Love List*, *Outlaw*, *Lunenburg*, *Old Love*, *Looking*, *Halfway There* and *Mending Fences*.

He is the recipient of the Los Angeles Drama-Logue Award for his play *The Melville Boys*, The Beverly Hills NAACP award for his play *The Motor Trade*, and in 2009 he was a finalist for the Ontario Premier's Award For Excellence In The Arts. He is an Officer of The Order of Canada. The Order of Canada is how Canada honours people who make extraordinary contributions to the nation.

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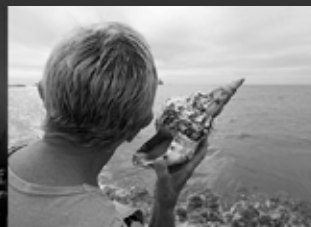
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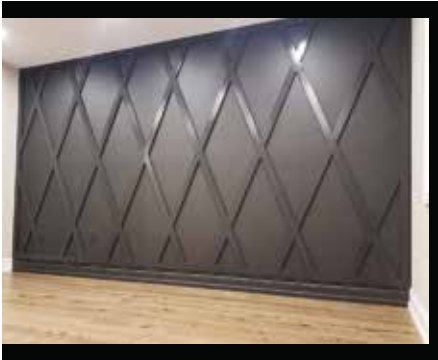
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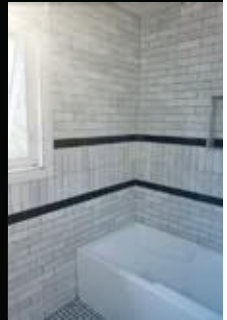
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
